EBUS to SEE-U.S.

5-week Summer Educational Experience in California

July 3 – August 6, 2011

Coastline Community College and California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) are proud to announce a 5-week Educational program open to all EBUS students.

Every student will receive **four weeks of Intensive English Language instruction**, taught by CSULB instructors.

Student's who qualify, will also be eligible for **one college-level course taught by a Coastline instructor**.

Students will also:

- Enjoy weekend excursions to sites like **Disneyland, Hollywood**, and the **J. Paul Getty Museum**.
- Go on weekly field trips to local cultural venues, such as the **Aquarium of the Pacific**, the historic **Rancho Los Alamitos**, the **Japanese Gardens**, and the **Bowers Museum of Cultural Art**.
- Participate in a one week tour of the west coast of the United States including sites such as **the Grand Canyon, Yosemite, and San Francisco**.

Students will be hosted by and **live on the campus of California State University Long Beach** and will have full use of the campus library, recreation facilities, and computer lab.

This valuable first-hand experience will introduce students to the United States, California, and U.S. university life and customs.

1. **The cost for this experience (excluding airfare) is US \$6,000 per student.**
***If fewer than 20 students apply for the program the cost will increase by an additional US \$500 per student.**
2. **The US \$1,000 non-refundable deposit AND completed application form are due no later than March 1, 2011. Students who do not submit by this deadline will not be eligible to participate due to Visa processing restrictions.**
3. **The final payment of US \$5000 (*US \$5,500 if fewer than 20 students register) is due June 1, 2011.**

Please book all flights for Los Angeles arrivals and San Francisco departures.

The cost for teachers/chaperones is US \$2880/per person (excluding airfare).

One chaperone is required for every 12 students (if more than 12 students register two chaperones will be required).
