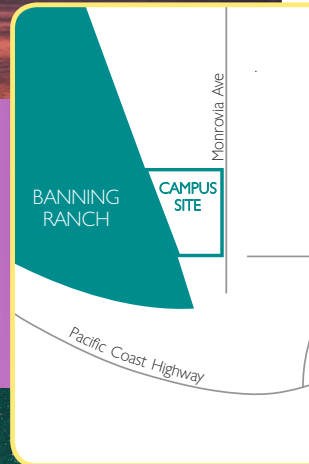

about the Newport Beach Campus:

- Built on 3.91 acres of previously developed land.
- Adjacent to Banning Ranch project.
- Scheduled to open to students in Fall 2012.
- First community college campus in Newport Beach to offer:

 - > Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) Program



ACQUIRED BRAIN INJURY PROGRAM (ABI)



- Early College High School (in partnership with Newport Mesa Unified School District) (Note: Coastline is a sister college to Orange Coast College, which already operates the renowned School of Sailing and Seamanship in Newport Beach).
- Campus will be built to Gold-LEED Certification standards, incorporating the following "green" features:
 - Native plants
 - Drought-tolerant landscaping
 - Irrigation via reclaimed water



PARALEGAL & SCIENCE



- Use of natural light and ventilation
- Designed by LPA, Inc., who also designed the new Environment Nature Center in Newport Beach.
- Construction team is managed by C.W.Driver.
- Campus is being built with measure C Funds (\$370 million voter approved bond measure in 2002). Bond funds from Measure C have made several projects possible within
