Educational Programs and Student Relationships

BP 4020 Curriculum Development and Approval

Education Code 78200, 78200.5 Title V 55100, 55130

The Chancellor of the Coast Community College District is charged with the responsibility for the development and establishment of the District's curriculum.

Curriculum Development

Courses of study offered and conducted by the colleges in the District shall be designed to fit the needs of potential and registered students. Courses and study programs which lose student support or otherwise become obsolescent shall be dropped from the curriculum.

The patterns of educational opportunity offered by the District shall demonstrate a balanced consideration of student needs including preparation for transfer to an upper division educational institution (grade 15 equivalent), occupational skills instruction, basic skills remediation, short-term vocational instruction, paraprofessional training, general education, and cultural and civic enrichment.

Curriculum Approval

All instructional programs and offerings will be subject to review and approval by the Chancellor and the Board of Trustees and shall conform to standards established by the District and the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges.

The District's educational programs shall be subject to approval by the Board of Governors, California Community Colleges, as prescribed by the Education Code and Title V Regulations.
