

**Coastline Community College 2010-11 A.A Degree Requirements
Option 3 - ACADEMIC ADVISING TRANSFER PLAN FOR IGEC**



Designed for individuals who plan to transfer to the University of California system or the California State University system and who also wish to complete an A.A degree. Students who complete this option with a "C" or better will satisfy lower-division general education requirements for the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC). Upon graduation, it meets the lower-division general education breadth requirements for both the UC and CSU systems (except for Eleanor Roosevelt and Revelle colleges at UCSD). The IGETC option also enables individuals to transfer to some of the private, four-year colleges in the area. Option 3 requires completion of at least 37 units of general education courses to include the specific requirements listed in Areas 1 - 6 plus at least 18 units in an Area of Emphasis or Major and elective units (numbered 100 - 200).
