BP 4025 Philosophy and Criteria for Associate Degree and General Education

Title 5, Section 55805

Philosophy

Each Coast Community College District college shall define its own Philosophy for Associate Degree and General Education and publish that philosophy in its catalog and other pertinent college materials. The college CEO shall establish procedures to assure that courses used to meet general education and associate degree requirements meet the standards in Title 5 Regulations. The procedures shall provide for appropriate Academic Senate involvement.

General Education Requirements

Each college shall maintain a current listing of general education and discipline major requirements for the AA/AS degrees and make them available in their respective college catalog and schedule of classes. All changes to the general education and discipline major requirements and to the AA/AS degrees shall be submitted by each college's Curriculum Committee for review by the Board of Trustees.

The general education requirements for the California State University system and the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) should be published in each college's catalog and schedule of classes.
