Dear President Adrian:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, at its meeting June 3-5, 2015, reviewed the Follow-Up Report submitted by Coastline Community College and the report of the evaluation team that visited on April 6, 2015. The College Follow-Up Report was certified by college and district leadership, including the chancellor, the president of the board of trustees, the college president, the Accreditation Liaison Officer, and leaders of the faculty, staff, and student organizations.

Based on the College Follow-Up Report, evidence submitted, and the Team Report, the Commission finds that Coastline Community College has addressed 2013 District Recommendation 2, resolved the deficiencies, and meets Standards IV.B.1.j, IV.B.3.a, and IV.B.3.g. The Commission also finds that the College has accelerated program reviews for all student services, learning resources and administrative resources and has completed all reviews with the exception of one remaining review due to be completed in fall 2015 thus completing the requirements of Commission Concern related to College Recommendation 4.

Institutions are expected to meet Eligibility Requirements, Accreditation Standards, and Commission policies at all times during the six-year review cycle. Coastline Community College must demonstrate to the Commission at the time of the Midterm Report that the recent changes implemented to resolve deficiencies and meet Standards have been sustained. Coastline Community College should submit the **Midterm Report by March 15, 2016.**¹

The Follow-Up Report submitted in March 2015 will become part of the accreditation history of the College. The Commission requires that you give the Follow-Up Report, the External Evaluation Team Report, and this letter appropriate dissemination to your College staff and to those who were signatories of your Follow-Up Report. This group should include the campus leadership and the Board of Trustees. The Commission also requires that these documents be made available to students and the public

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by placing a copy on the College website. *Please note that in response to public interest in disclosure, the Commission now requires institutions to post accreditation information on a page no more than one click from the institution's home page.*

Professional self-regulation is the responsibility of an accredited college and the accreditor. Thank you for sharing in that responsibility.
