2018-2019 Academic Senate Governance Survey Results

In order to support a culture of continuous quality improvement, Coastline conducts annual surveys across all shared governance committees as means to provide information to facilitate the development of strategies to strengthen committee effectiveness in the following year. The subsequent information provides a summary of the 2018-2019 survey results.

Participation Rate was 83.3% of the 30 members

Table 1 indicates that 86.4% of the time the committee always or often exhibits effective committee interactive behaviors with the highest categories being collaborative and transparent.

Over 90% of the committee members that participated indicated:

- They clearly understand the mandate of the committee
- The committees was on-time with the appropriate materials available
- The quality of communication from the committee to constituency groups and the college as a whole was rated highly favorable (good/very good).
- The quality of access to information, meeting space location and resources to conduct the committee were rated highly favorable (good/very good).
- The quality of communication within the committee was rated highly favorable (good/very good).
- Access to information and other resources was rated highly favorable (good/very good).
- The length of the meeting was appropriate

Highlighted accomplishments include: The committee passed the bylaws, RSI policies and procedures, and the committee continued to have strong communication.

Suggestions for improvement: The committee should consider assessing the size of the meeting space to accommodate members and guests and provide more onboarding opportunities for new members.
