



## 2019-2020 Professional Development and Leadership Committee Governance Survey Results

In order to support a culture of continuous quality improvement, Coastline conducts annual surveys across all shared governance committees as means to provide information to facilitate the development of strategies to strengthen committee effectiveness in the following year. The subsequent information provides a summary of the 2019-2020 survey results.

Participation Rate was 90.9% of the 11 members

Table 1 indicates that 100.0% of the time the committee always exhibits effective committee interactive behaviors with the highest category being collaborative, transparent, and efficient.

**100%** of the committee members that participated indicated:

- They felt comfortable contributing ideas, felt that they were treated with respect and have sufficient opportunity to provide input.
- The quality of communication within the committee was rated favorably (good/very good).
- The quality of the meeting space location and resources to conduct the committee were rated highly favorable (good/very good).
- The quality of information flow from constituency groups to the committee was rated favorably.
- The quality of communication by the committee with the campus community as a whole is favorable.
- Felt the meeting space was appropriate
- Had access to resources need for the meeting
- The meetings were held regularly, on-time, and that documents were made available in a timely manner

The highlighted **accomplishments** included finalizing the development of the Professional Development Plan, restructure of the professional development, and the Spring BBQ event. There were no **suggestions for improvement** made.
