



2017-2018 Facilities, Safety, and Sustainability Committee Governance Survey Results

In order to support a culture of continuous quality improvement, Coastline conducts annual surveys across all shared governance committees as means to provide information to facilitate the development of strategies to strengthen committee effectiveness in the following year. The subsequent information provides a summary of the 2017-2018 survey results.

Participation Rate was 71.4% of the 14 members

Table 1 indicates that 92.0% of the time the committee always exhibits effective committee interactive behaviors with the highest categories being collaborative, and effective (100.0%). All participants felt that all interactive committee behaviors are exercised almost always or often.

100% of the committee members that participated indicated:

- They felt comfortable sharing ideas, felt that they were treated with respect and have sufficient opportunity to provide input.
- The quality of information within the committee and to the constituency was rated highly favorable (good/very good).
- The quality of access to information, meeting space location and resources to conduct the committee were rated highly favorable (good/very good).

The highlighted **accomplishments** included various renovations, such as to the Westminster update, new College Center building, and continually host structured and effective meetings. There were no **suggestions for improvement**.
