



2017-2018 Student Success Committee Governance Survey Results

In order to support a culture of continuous quality improvement, Coastline conducts annual surveys across all shared governance committees as means to provide information to facilitate the development of strategies to strengthen committee effectiveness in the following year. The subsequent information provides a summary of the 2017-2018 survey results.

Participation Rate was 63.2% of the 19 members

Table 1 indicates that 55.5% of the time the committee always exhibits effective committee interactive behaviors with the highest categories being collaborative, transparent, effective and efficient (58.3%). Overall, the majority of participants felt that all effective committee behaviors are exercised between the often and always categories.

Over 80% of the committee members that participated indicated:

- They felt comfortable sharing ideas, felt that they were treated with respect and have sufficient opportunity to provide input.
- The quality of access to information, meeting space location and resources to conduct the committee were rated highly favorable (good/very good).
- The committee operates effectively.

The highlighted **accomplishments** included the completing the integrated BSI/Equity/SSSP Plan, creating the student success philosophy. The **suggestions for improvement** included redefining the directive of the committee and increase the rate of member attendance.
