Table 1 presents a two-year comparison which looks at the job placement rate of CTE program completers that did not enroll in a four-year institution. Based on the 2013-2014 job placement cohort tracking methodology, the findings showed overall job placement rates at 25.5%. The assessment at the program level indicated that 47.6% of the programs met the population inclusion threshold (n-sizes over 10).
