Eligibility – Educational Level

- Students who first enroll in a program of study on or after July 1, 2012, will be ineligible for federal financial aid if they do not have a high school diploma, or a General Education Diploma (GED), or passed the California Proficiency Examination (CHSPE), or do not meet the State's home school requirements.
- If this item is needed for your file, it appears you do not qualify for financial aid based on the Educational Level you have reported.
- If you have made an error, please update your Educational Level by providing proof of completion (H.S diploma, GED, CHSPE) directly to the Admissions Office.
- If you have not graduated high school, received a GED, or passed the California Proficiency Examination, but you enrolled in a program of study **before July 1, 2012** AND you have completed 6 college units or have passed the ATB test, please submit proof of this to the Financial Aid Office.
