Dear Coastline Student,

I am writing to share an update regarding health services for Coastline students.

Beginning with the Fall 2020 semester, after Coastline students pay their health fee to Coastline College they can receive services at the <u>Golden West College</u> or the <u>Orange Coast College Student Health Centers</u>. (Please note that we no longer have a contract with Memorial Care.)

With the support of our Associated Student Government (ASG), we moved forward with this idea for several reasons:

- Many of our students take courses at GWC and/or OCC, so the facilities are convenient.
- This keeps Coastline College health fee revenues within the District and not going to a third party.
- The Health Centers at our sister colleges are **student-focused**, and I can personally attest to their passion, compassion, and quality of care.

ASG also supported raising student health fees, to ensure District-wide equity in what students are paying.

- For 2020-2021, the fee is \$16 a semester (up from \$11)
- For 2021-2022, the fee will increase to \$21 a semester (in line with our sister colleges)

An important note and an answer to a common question: **Health fees are State-mandated fees** and <u>waiving</u> <u>those fees</u> are limited to the following criteria:

- A student belongs to a church or religious organization that depends solely on prayer for healing.
- A student is enrolled only in courses of less than two weeks duration.

Health fee waivers for Coastline are processed through our Admissions and Records Office.

If a student also enrolled in courses at GWC and/or OCC, they do not have to pay health fees at our sister colleges, just Coastline. They should apply for a waiver at the other college(s); if they already paid health fees also at GWC or OCC, they can receive a refund. (A student can show proof of payment of Coastline health fees.)

Both Student Health Centers are providing tele-health during this time of remote work. See below:
