



Coastline Promise Program

Program Information:

The purpose of the Coastline Promise is to ensure that recent high school graduates have the best chance of completing a college degree or career and technical education (CTE) certificate by offering financial and academic support in their first year of college. Recent high school graduates from Newport-Mesa, Huntington Beach, and Garden Grove districts are eligible to apply to the Coastline College Promise.

The Coastline Promise Program provides students with the following benefits:

1. Per unit fees, college service and health services fees covered for the fall and spring semesters of your first year (summer and winter intersession are excluded)
2. Textbook vouchers of up to \$1,000 for the first year *
3. Priority Registration
4. Free Tutoring Services in Key Courses
5. Dedicated Counseling, Academic Success Coaches, and Career Services

To become a part of the Coastline Promise Program, students must:

1. Graduate from Newport-Mesa, Huntington Beach, or Garden Grove high school district during the most recent school year.
2. Complete the Coastline College Promise Student Application. If you are under 18 years old, your parent/guardian signature is also required. Submit the completed forms to the Coastline Community College Outreach Department via mail, email, or in-person.
3. Complete the Coastline Community College online application for Fall 2018 via OpenCCC.
4. Complete the 2018-2019 FAFSA to apply for Financial Aid. Coastline Community College FAFSA School Code: 013536
5. Complete online orientation.
6. Complete English and Math Placement Tests.
7. See a counselor to develop a comprehensive Student Education Plan (SEP).

DEADLINE: May 4, 2018**

*Students will receive textbook vouchers up to \$500 for fall and spring semesters if enrolled full-time (12-15 units/semester) and \$250/semester for part-time (9-11 units/semester) enrollment. Winter intersession units will not be counted towards spring units/semester. Textbook vouchers will not be available for summer or winter intersession classes.

**Applications will be accepted through the deadline or until the Coastline Promise Program reaches capacity, whichever occurs first.



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Coastline Promise Participation Agreement

I understand that the Coastline Community College Promise Program is designed to support my college success in completing a degree and/or certificate.

Students are eligible to receive:

1. Per unit fees, college service and health services fees covered for the fall and spring semesters of your first year (summer and winter intersession are excluded)
2. Textbook Support of up to \$1,000.00 dollars. Students will receive vouchers up to \$500 for fall and spring semesters for full-time (12 -15 units/semester) and \$250/semester for part-time (9-11 units/semester) enrollment. Winter intersession units will not be counted towards spring units/semester. Textbook vouchers will not be available for summer or winter intersession classes.
3. Academic, personal, and career counseling each semester, including the development of a comprehensive Student Education Plan and the support needed to understand and follow that plan.
4. Other activities, support services, and events designed to help students successfully complete their educational goals.

Students must agree to the following requirements:

1. I must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 units per semester.
2. I will enroll in appropriate English and math courses during my first semesters at Coastline Community College so that I have the skills I need to be successful in all of my other college courses.
3. I will enroll in the Counseling C105 success course designed to identify my needs as a student and to connect me with appropriate resources and support.
4. I will maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and complete at least 67% of the courses attempted each semester. If necessary, I will participate in academic intervention activities to regain my good standing.
5. I will complete 20 hours of community service during my first year at Coastline by the following deadlines: 10 hours by December 7, 2018, and 10 additional hours by April 3, 2019.
6. I will adhere to all Coastline Community College's policies related to academic progress, financial aid, and other Coastline Community College requirements.
7. I will communicate with Coastline Promise staff, counselors, tutors, and/or faculty regularly to get the support I need both academically and personally.
8. I will participate in learning community activities, support services, and other events provided by the College Promise Program that support my academic goals.
9. I will abide by the attendance requirements set forth by my instructors, understanding that there are consequences for excessive absences and being tardy to class.
10. I will follow the courses outlined in my Student Education Plan. Failing to do so without approval from a counselor will disqualify me from the program. For any changes to my educational plan, I will meet with a counselor to ensure my continued academic success.
11. I will accept responsibility for all learning activities and complete course requirements.
12. I will motivate others by demonstrating a positive example of an engaged and responsible student.
13. I will meet with a counselor at least once per semester and a success coach at least twice per semester to review my Educational Plan. I will meet with a counselor and a success coach prior to the spring 2019 registration appointment. If enrolled in ENG 099 and/or Math 030, I agree to meet with a counselor at least once per semester and a success coach a minimum of four times per semester.

*A success workshop may count as one (1) meeting with a success coach. I may substitute a maximum of two (2) workshops for success coach meetings each semester.

Failure to meet all of the above requirements will affect my participation in the Coastline Promise Program and all associated benefits.
