Dear Dr. Adrian:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, at its meeting January 13-15, 2021, reviewed the Follow-Up Report and related evidentiary materials submitted by Coastline Community College. The Commission also considered the spoken testimony of Dr. Loretta Adrian, President and Dr. Vince Rodriguez, Vice President of Instruction. The Commission found these additional perspectives to be helpful.

The purpose of this review was to determine whether the College has appropriately responded to the issues as identified by the peer review team at the time of the last visit and as expressed in the Commission's Action Letter of June 28, 2019, and whether the College has demonstrated compliance with the related Standards.

Upon consideration of the information noted above, the Commission acted to **Reaffirm Accreditation for the remainder of the cycle**. The Commission finds that Coastline Community College has addressed the compliance requirements, corrected deficiencies, and meets Standard II.A.3. The next report from the College will be the Midterm Report<sup>1</sup> due on March 15, 2023. The institution's next comprehensive review will occur in the spring term of 2026.

The Commission requires the College to disseminate the Follow-Up Report, and this letter within the institution, including by posting them on the College's website.

On behalf of the Commission, we wish to express appreciation for the diligent work and thoughtful reflection that Coastline Community College undertook to respond to these
