
The California College Promise Grant waives per-unit tuition fees for students planning to or currently attending a California community college who are CA residents (or exempt from non-resident fees under the California Dream Act), and who have a financial need.

The CARE

(Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education) program assists single parent students with at least one child under 14 who are receiving public assistance (CalWORKs/TANF) by providing the academic, personal, and financial support to students whose educational and socioeconomic backgrounds limit their ability to be academically successful.

NEXTUP

Like CARE, this program is part of Coastline's Extended Opportunity Programs & Services (EOPS) and provides direct aid, support services, and other resources to current and former foster youth who are pursuing their educational goals.

The **Westminster Le-Jao Campus** prides itself in promoting a learning environment that respects and meets the individual needs of Coastline's diverse student population. As part of an integrated educational/civic complex, a system of courtyards, terraces, and walkways create a functional and communal space for learning and enjoyment. This campus houses computer labs, English learning labs, the General Education and ESL departments, and a Student Success Center, among other special programs.

Full-Service Student Success Centers are located at our Westminster Le-Jao Campus, Garden Grove, and Newport campuses, with drop-in tutoring across all disciplines, study space, printing, and computers with individual tutoring available at our Student Services Center located in Fountain Valley.

Coastline's **Garden Grove Campus** houses our career and technical education (CTE) programs and hosts a wide variety of activities such as Pathway Days, CyberPatriot competitions, workshops, trainings, articulation events, and community outreach activities such as tax preparation and regional meetings. In addition to these activities, the campus supports the activities of the Transfer Center, Counseling, the International Resource Center, and Coastline's NetLab, which gives students access to a real laboratory by the way of the internet 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.







Coastline offers 8-week online, mobile-friendly courses. In addition to short-term classes, ELD offers five sessions per academic year.


