

## **2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The following must be included in the scholarship application:

- 1. 2024 Scholarship Application
- 2. A letter or current transcript from the applicant's school certifying that the applicant is a student in good standing.
- 3. An essay of under 500 words covering the following topics:
  - a. Your involvement, in any public service or leadership role, within the community
  - b. Your reason for attending college
  - c. Whether or how you expect to use your education to contribute to the community
  - d. Letters of recommendation are optional in electronic version

Your essay will have the greatest weight in the evaluation of your application and should be carefully prepared. Although the above information is the primary deciding factor, financial need is also another factor. You may send supporting financial information.
